What is School-Wide Positive Behavior Support?

Positive Behavior Support is an exciting new approach to handling discipline. In a school setting, it cannot be assumed that students know correct behaviors. Students come from different backgrounds and cultures that view behavior in their own unique ways. When a child misbehaves, the school views it as a skill deficit. Therefore, students are taught appropriate school behaviors and expectations. Students are rewarded when they display the expected behavior. Narcoossee students receive Bear Bucks from adults on campus which can be used to “purchase” items from the Bear Buck store or participate in regularly scheduled activities on campus. Events are also scheduled during the year for students who maintain good grades and positive behavior.

Consequences are still given for inappropriate behavior. These consequences may include:

- Telephone calls to parents
- Loss of privileges
- Wednesday detention
- Saturday detention
- In-School Suspension (ISS)
- Out of School Suspension (OSS)

- Form straight line, be quiet & raise hand when bell rings

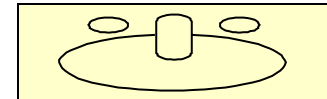
Classroom Expectations
