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Course Description

AVID (application only-full year) – If interested please complete an application and see Ms. Bartlett or Ms. Madorin for additional information when they visit your school.

Band I/Developing – The purpose is to learn a new instrument in this full year course. Students will perform in Winter and Spring Concerts. No previous music knowledge is necessary but practice time is part of the expectations. (May waive P.E. Option-full year) \$

Chorus I – Basic vocal music instruction (May waive P.E. Option-full year) \$

Exploring Spanish – Instruction is provided in basic language skills as related to Spanish

Intro to Dance Techniques – Introduces various types of dance styles during the semester course

Orchestra I – Beginning and basic musical strings class (May waive P.E. Option-full year) \$

Physical Education - Active participation course which demonstrates a wide variety of skills. This course is included as an option on every student's elective interest. However, some year long elective course may waive a student from participating in a Physical Education course. (P.E. uniform are sold at open house or during first week of the class. \$)

STEM for 6th graders – These two courses are for a full year and cover engineering design and the science behind technology. (May waive P.E. Option) \$

Theatre/Drama – full year course that explores theatre's social and cultural influences as well as performance, visual art and music. (May waive P.E. Option) \$
